AWARDS POLICY

As the Presentation Day is coming up, it's timely to remind Athletes and Parents/Guardians about the awards policy.

To be eligible for an Award, an Athlete must have competed in at least 70% of the meets held since the Athlete registered. An Athlete must compete in at least 50% of the events held at a Meet to be considered to have competed.

We try to reward as many Athletes as possible and are flexible in applying these rules where Athletes are just outside meeting the criteria.

If you are concerned that you may miss out on an award for some reason, or there are special circumstances we need to consider, please raise your concern with the Committee ASAP.

In all we raised \$1500 for the centre! A great effort by all concerned.

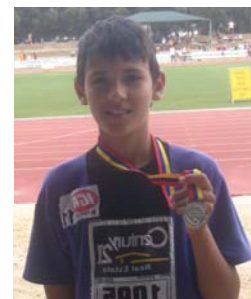
CROSS COUNTRY
